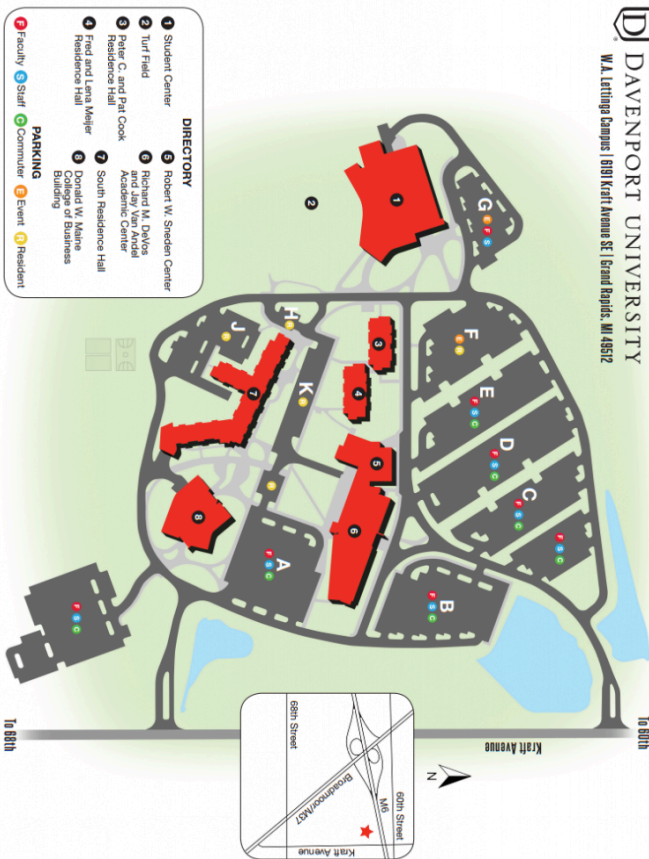

REMINDERS FOR ALL STUDENTS

All students **must** move-in to their assigned spaces

The Housing & Residence Life Department encourages purchasing **Renter's Insurance** to protect your belongings.

NEW STUDENTS

First Year Student Move-In:
August 28th

Transfer Student Move-In:
August 29th

Move-in happens alphabetically, starting at **9:00am**.

- **A-D:** 9:00am-10:00am
- **E-K:** 10:00am-11:00am
- **L-R:** 11:00am-12:00pm
- **S-Z:** 12:00pm-1:00pm

Move-In starts at the Welcome Desk in the academic building, and our team will direct you from there to your various housing placements.

SUGGESTED ITEMS TO BRING

Individual Students:

- Luggage or totes, clothes, toiletries, and a shower caddy.
- 3M wall-hanging strips, Twin XL bedding (sheets, blankets, pillow, mattress pad), wastebasket, desk or floor lamp.
- School supplies, umbrella, laundry basket with detergent, and personal ID (health insurance card, ID, social security card).

Shared with Roommates:

- Household essentials: iron and ironing board, bath mat, cleaning products, first aid supplies, small toolkit, and flashlight.
- Kitchen basics: dishes, utensils, and microwavable foods.
- Optional items: television (with QAM tuner).
- Cook Hall only: shower curtain.

ITEMS NOT TO BRING

- Alcohol, drugs (and paraphernalia), weapons, fireworks, candles, laser pointers, LED rope lights, peel-and-stick wallpaper, and pets (except fish in tanks under 10 gallons).
- Items that obstruct doorways (e.g., beaded curtains, fishnets), anything requiring holes in the walls, appliances with open heating elements (e.g., toasters, space heaters), and additional furniture.

RETURNING STUDENTS

Move-In Date:
August 29th

Move-in happens alphabetically, starting at **9:00am**, identical to New Students

Students should **NOT** remove any Davenport furniture from their designated space.

We encourage to limit belongings to one carload; avoid large items like beds or couches.



INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Move-In Date:
August 26th, 9:00am-2:00pm

Please contact Admissions and Housing directly to share your flight details, especially if flights do not align with the scheduled move-in date.

International kits are provided on move-in day. The kits contain towels, bedding, and other basic essentials to get you started.
